

The Counsel General of India in Johannesburg arranged a formal dinner with about 25 doctors on 7th May 2016.

Chief of Durban convention bureau and the City Mayor hosted a formal dinner on 9th May. These formal meetings were arranged by local doctors at Johannesburg and Durban.

Dinner meeting organized by the chief of Durban convention bureau was attended by, the V.C. of the Natal University, Speaker of the House and City Mayor. There was wide publicity in press and media.

#### Highlights of coverage:

President of GAPIO Dr. Sanku Rao said that although the focus has been on India, North America and Europe so far, it was now shifting to Africa and other countries of the globe. The Global Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (GAPIO) is keen to establish a South African chapter to work closely with local people and help reduce health inequalities.

"Indian-origin doctors have been rallying and coming together to do something good on their own for many years wherever they are, but collectively we can do even more," said Mr Anwar Feroz Siddiqi, US-based Advisor to GAPIO. Emphasising that Indian-origin doctors should look at what they could do in the countries that they have adopted as their home. "They should identify issues pertinent to their countries and help locals overcome those challenges. "By doing so we increase our profile and integrate better in the societies we have settled in," Siddiqi said.

The concept of bringing together South Africans of Indian-origin is therefore not a new idea because community-based organisations have had their services for a long time. It would of course be nice to be part of an international organisation, "Sooboo said.

# **Gandhi Fair**

**BENGALURU:** Dr. Narinder Kapur collects books from London and sells them to Indian students at a cheaper price. All the proceeds will go to help those suffering from diseases like dementia and acid burns. The 66-year-old professor of neuropsychology at the University of London lives with the Gandhian ideology 'surplus to seva' to the core..

Narinder Kapur's Gandhi Fair offers books from the fields of neuroscience, cognition and psychology to students at one-tenth the market price or less.

In Bengaluru to take part in the Global Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (GAPIO) meeting on Saturday, Kapur said: "This initiative helps in three ways---people in the UK can dispose of items they no longer need, students and others in India can buy them at a bargain price and an Indian charity benefits from the proceeds of the fair. If there is surplus in one part of the world, why can't it be used to help others in need elsewhere? The concept of surplus can apply to other domains like food banks and surplus seats on flights that could be given to charity workers."

Known for his fight against corrupt practices in the Britain's National Health Service (NHS), Kapur lost a flourishing career in 2010 when he raised concerns on patient safety while serving as head of neuropsychology at Addenbrooke's Hospital in Cambridge. But that did not stop him from helping the needy. He has been hosting 'Gandhi Fair' every year in India since 2013.

"The first event was in Kolkata in 2013. I have since then held fairs in Chennai and Mumbai. This is my fourth major fair. I started this because I was inspired by Gandhiji's principles of truth and love. Truth is embodied in knowledge and science; love is embodied in compassion for others."

Settled in the UK since 1952, the sexagenarian finds his Indian self through Mahatma Gandhi and his simple way of life.
