The annual observance and celebration of World Heart Day was held on Sept. 29 this year with the theme "Use Heart to connect". This day was intended to raise public awareness about Cardiovascular Disease (CVD) and take measures to prevent heart diseases. On this occasion, an Indian American Physician Dr. Vemuri S Murthy was Honored as 'Global Champion of Resuscitation'.

Dr. Vemuri S Murthy, an alumnus of Guntur Medical College, Guntur All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, and a former chairman of the Anesthesiology Department at West Suburban Medical Center, Oak Park, Illinois have been hailed as a "pioneer of resuscitation medicine in India."

His contributions to global health, resuscitation medicine, and community service have been widely recognized with numerous awards.

Dr. Murthy was honored with a Medal from US Congressmen as Global Champion of Resuscitation, Lifetime Achievement Award, and Distinguished Physician Award from the Indian American Medical Association, Illinois.




GAPIO appreciates the contribution of Physiotherapists on account of World Physical Therapy Day

- problems with memory and concentration




GAPIO shared a message through the social media platforms stating that genetic testing proves beneficial in prescribing effective blood thinners.



Raising an awareness about Suicide Prevention during the fast paced life causing emotional stress and trauma, is a must!





World Heart Day


We all know that having a good heart is essential to live a long and healthy life and it is the emotional organ of our body which treasures feelings, emotions and health.
