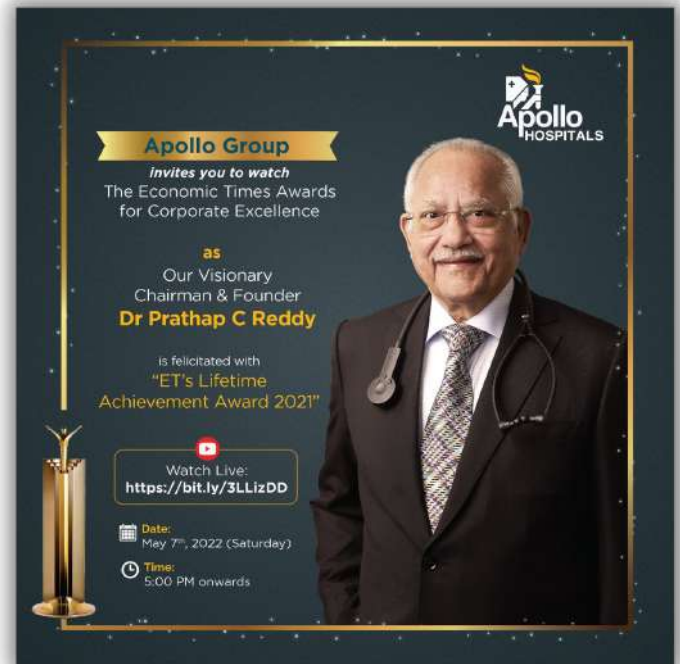

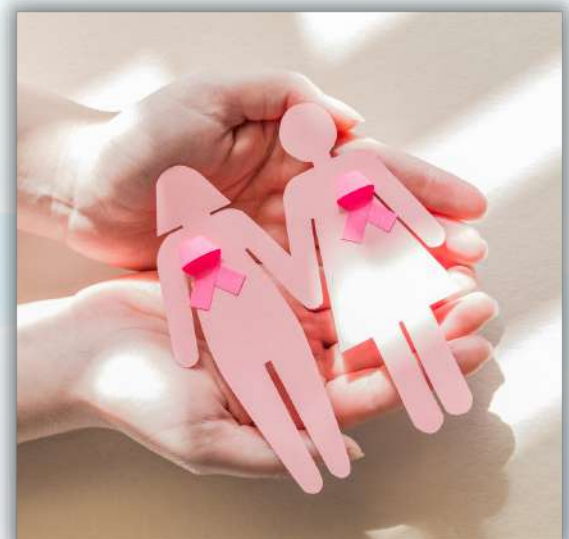
Dr. Anupam Sibal (President, GAPIO) shared the lessons that COVID has taught in this summit.

Breast cancer Treatment time to be reduced by 90%

Multinational Pharma Company Roche has combined two monoclonal antibodies that can be administered by single injection, thus reducing the treatment time by 90%.

It launched the new drug PHESGO which is a combination of Perjeta (pertuzumab) and Herceptin (trastuzumab) with hyaluronidase. It will also likely reduce the treatment cost by 20%.

Chronic Fatigue Syndrome or CFS is an extremely debilitating and socially isolating disease that affects more than 1 million individuals worldwide.

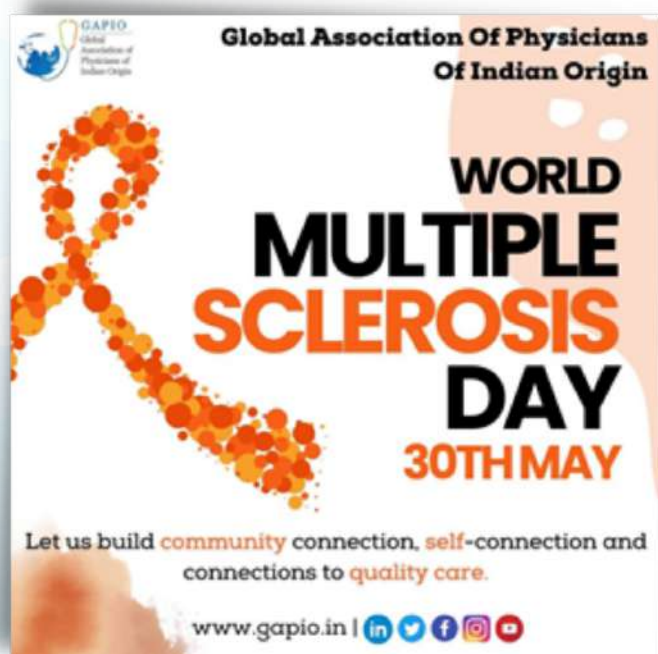
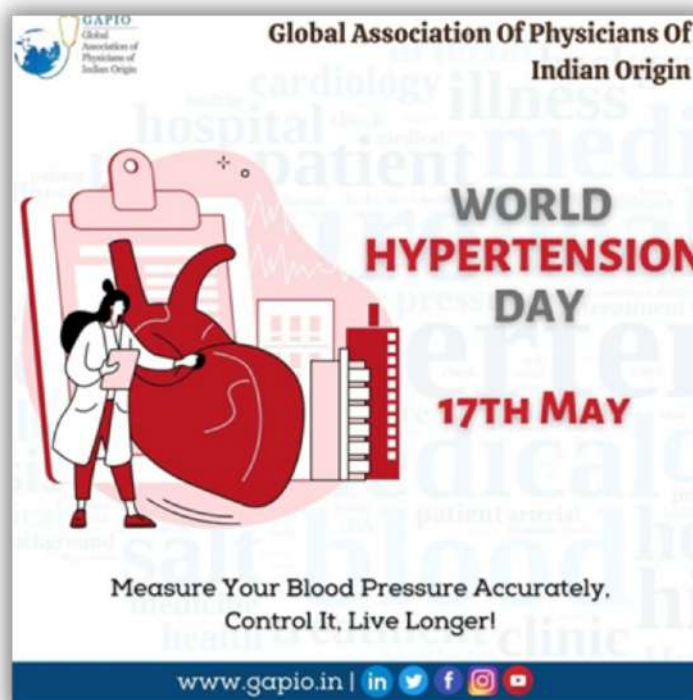


World Hypertension Day

Prevents heart attack, stroke, and kidney damage, as well as other problems by reducing blood pressure or by keeping it in control with treatment. For prevention, Reduce salt and oil intake, stop smoking, do regular exercise, keep weight under control and avoid any kind of stress and these will help in controlling and maintaining blood pressure at a normal level GAPIO appealed all to be aware and to monitor or examine blood pressure from time to time to avoid any complications.
