Dr. Vinod Balachandran leads mRNA vaccines trial for pancreatic cancer



Dr. Vinod Balachandran, an Indian American physician-scientist is leading the only clinical trial to test Messenger RNA (mRNA) vaccines, which helped turn the tide against Covid-19, for pancreatic cancer.

Dr. Balachandran presented encouraging results from the phase 1 trial at the annual meeting of the American Society of Clinical Oncology on June 5. In 8 of 16 patients studied, the vaccines activated T cells that recognize the patient's pancreatic cancers. These patients also showed delayed recurrence of their pancreatic cancers, suggesting the T cells activated by the vaccines may be having the desired effect to keep pancreatic cancers in check.

Dr. Balachandran discussed how collaboration with BioNTech — which developed the Pfizer-BioNTech Covid-19 vaccine — led to this potential treatment for pancreatic cancer.

A team of researchers at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center (MSK) had already been working to use mRNA vaccine technology to treat cancer even before the pandemic began.

The key to these vaccines appears to be proteins in the pancreatic tumors, called neoantigens, which alert the immune system to keep cancer at bay, says Balachandran.

Surgeon General Vivek Murthy Issues Advisory on Health Worker Burnout



Surgeon General Vivek Murthy, MD, issued a new advisory that underscores the urgent need to support the health workforce and respond to the burnout crisis.

The advisory outlines recommendations that health care organizations, federal, state, local, and tribal governments, health insurers and payers, health care technology companies, academic institutions, clinical training programs, and health workers can take to address health worker burnout, while also building a thriving workforce and strengthening the public health infrastructure.

Notable recommendations in the advisory include:

- Transform workplace culture to empower health workers and be responsive to their voices and needs.
- Eliminate punitive policies for seeking mental health and substance use disorder care
- Protect the health, safety, and well-being of all health workers.
- Reduce administrative burdens to help health workers have productive time with patients, communities, and colleagues.
- Prioritize social connection and community as a core value of the healthcare system.
- Invest in public health and public health workforce.

Free Cardio Diabetic Health Check-up camp

Free Cardio Diabetic health check-up camp in association with GAPIO was organized by Dr. Ashish Aneja on the occasion of International Yoga Day on 21 June 2022.

The camp hosted Blood Glucose testing, Blood Pressure, ECG, Neuropathy and Spirometry, Weight, BMI, and Hemoglobin testing at no cost.

Free consultation was also provided to all with free medicine distribution.

Dr. Aneja told that we have to face several difficulties in treating common metabolic disorders due to a lack of awareness among patients. So to cope with this situation regular follow-up and lifestyle modifications, and proper medication are necessary. Viral fever is at its peak nowadays so to avoid many communicable viral infections we have to be fit enough to avoid these infections and follow some simple steps like frequent hand wash, regular citrus fruits, salad intake, and yoga.

He also conveyed that due to a sedentary lifestyle Diabetes, Hypertension, and Heart Failure is increasing day by day so a regular walk of a minimum of 30 minutes is enough to prevent lifestyle-related disorders.

On the occasion of International Yoga Day, GAPIO appealed all to keep themselves fit and fine by doing Yoga on a regular basis by sharing the following message on social media:

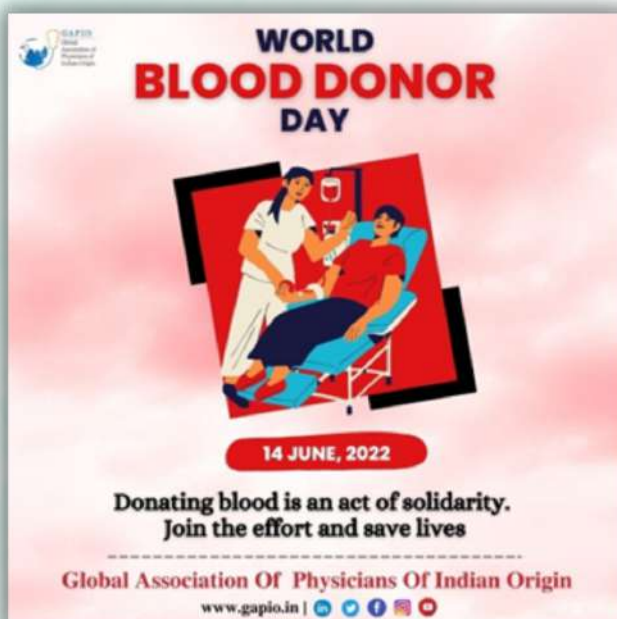
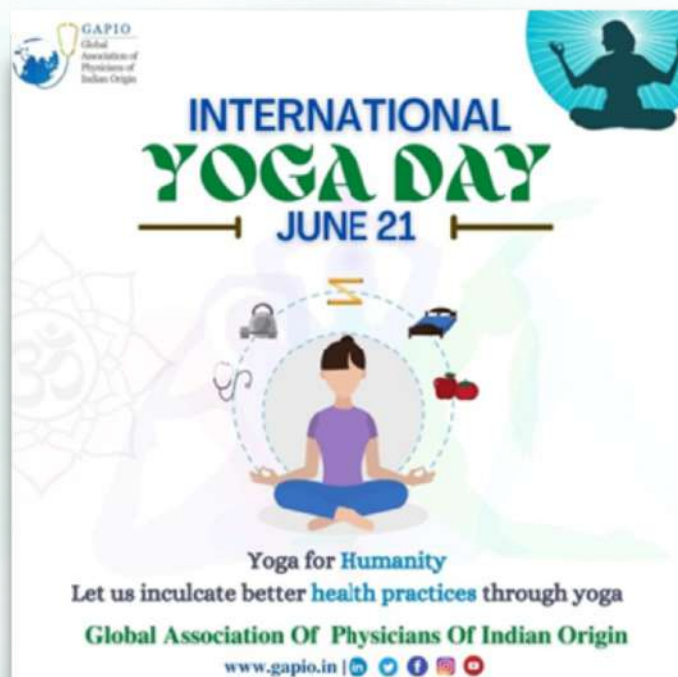
Yoga as an art to keep fit and healthy, has been existing for many-many years; rather this has become a unique tool in maintaining both physical and mental well-being.
