

GAPIO's XIII Annual Conference - Sessions Overview

The XIII Annual Conference of the Global Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (GAPIO) held on 11 - 12 February 2023 at The Leela Gandhinagar, Gujarat, covered a wide range of sessions on various medical topics. The It provided an opportunity for attendees to learn from experts in their respective fields and to exchange ideas on the latest medical advancements.

Session: Cardiac Sciences

A software tries to spot lung cancer years earlier. Can it?

Lung cancer is the deadliest, so catching it early is one of the best ways for patients to survive.

Now researchers have created an artificial intelligence tool that could predict whether a person will get lung cancer up to six years in advance, paving the way for doctors to spot tumors that are notoriously hard to detect early.

The finding, announced in late January by a team of researchers at Harvard's Massachusetts General Hospital and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, is part of a growing medical trend of using algorithms to predict everything from breast and prostate cancer to the likelihood of tumors regrowing. Though research is increasing, scientists say more testing needs to be done before fully unleashing these products into clinical settings.

The tool is Sybil, named after the prophet in ancient Greek literature. It is a deep-learning model, meaning computers parse through huge data sets to identify and categorize patterns. Sybil was trained on six years of lung scans of patients in the United States and Taiwan.

The study results showed Sybil achieved scores scientifically considered "good" and "strong" in predicting lung cancer over six years. It was stronger with its one-year prediction rates.

Three Indian-Americans in New York named in Health Care Power 100 list

Three physicians of Indian origin have been included in City & State's Health Care Power 100 list, which recognizes decision-makers in the medical world in New York. The list considers legislative victories, labor battles, newly launched initiatives, and other noteworthy developments from the past 12 months. The physicians recognized for their contribution during the pandemic are Dr Ashwin Vasan, commissioner at the New York City Department of Health & Mental Hygiene; Dr Darshana Srinivasan, chief of the Health Care Bureau at the State Attorney General's Office; and Parag Mehta, president of the Medical Society of the State of New York. Dr. Vasan, who took over as the city's health commissioner in March 2022, advised New Yorkers to wear masks in transit and indoors when the virus threw the 'tripled emic' at the city in December. Dr. Srinivasan has already obtained refunds for pharmacy customers wrongfully charged for COVID-19 vaccines and reached a \$13 million agreement with UnitedHealthcare to pay consumers illegally denied mental health coverage. Dr. Mehta is a leading advocate for improving public health and physician well-being and restoring the joy of medicine in New York.




