INDIAN CARDIOLOGIST DR. ARIJIT GHOSH SAVES CLINICALLY DEAD PATIENT IN UK WITH INNOVATIVE DEFIBRILLATION METHOD

Dr. Arijit Ghosh, an Indian cardiologist, has revived Sarbjit Singh, who was clinically dead for 45 minutes following a cardiac arrest. He applied a pioneering method called double sequential external defibrillation, which involves using two defibrillators and delivering shocks in quick succession. Following this success, the technique is gaining acceptance in the UK medical community. Dr. Ghosh is actively promoting this life-saving method worldwide, aiming to bring about a transformative change in cardiac emergency protocols.

DR. MANDEEP SINGH, UAE-BASED INDIAN-ORIGIN FETAL MEDICINE EXPERT, FIRST TO PERFORM COMPLEX IN-UTERO SURGERY

Dr. Mandeep Singh, an Indian-origin fetal medicine expert based in Abu Dhabi, has made history as the first Indian-origin doctor to perform a complex in-utero procedure. Dr. Singh led a team at Burjeel Medical City in successfully operating on a 24-week old fetus diagnosed with spina bifida, a congenital defect where the spine and spinal cord do not form properly.

This pioneering operation was performed on a patient from Colombia who sought to prevent short-term and long-term complications for her baby. The technique, known as in-utero spina bifida repair, requires high precision and is offered at only about 14 centers worldwide.


