

DR. T.S. CHANDRASEKAR APPOINTED ACADEMIC GOVERNOR OF ACG FOR INDIA

INDIAN ARMY'S FIRST FEMALE SURGEON IN ELITE PARA SPECIAL FORCES: MAJOR DR. PAYAL CHHABRA

In a momentous achievement, **Major Dr. Payal Chhabra** became the first woman surgeon to join the esteemed Para Special Forces of the Indian Army. Hailing from Jind district, Haryana, Major Chhabra was awarded the symbolic Maroon Beret during a ceremony in Agra.

Her father, Dr. Rajender Chhabra, expressed immense pride in her accomplishments, highlighting her unique feat of completing the rigorous para probation training while concurrently serving as a doctor in the military.

Educationally, Major Chhabra earned her MBBS and subsequently pursued an MS in surgery. Post-education, she worked as a senior resident doctor in the surgery department of Kalpana Chawla Government Medical College, Karnal, Haryana. Currently, she serves as a specialist surgeon at the Army Hospital in Ladakh. Prior to this, she was stationed at the Army Hospital in Khardungla and began her military medical career as a captain at Ambala's Army Hospital in January 2021.

Choosing national service over lucrative offers from prominent hospitals both nationally and internationally, Major Chhabra's determination and dedication to her country is evident.

The journey to becoming a Para Commando in the Indian Army is notoriously rigorous. Emphasizing both physical and mental tenacity, the training for Para SF requires candidates to achieve exceptional fitness levels. Detailing her demanding training regimen, Major Chhabra spoke of beginning her training sessions in the early hours and undertaking grueling 40-kilometer runs, sometimes carrying weights ranging from 20 to 65 kg.
