
INDIAN-ORIGIN ANESTHESIOLOGIST RECEIVES ASA EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION AWARD

INDIAN-ORIGIN PHYSICIANS RECEIVE 2023 HUMANITARIAN GRANT

Dr. Samit Sunny Roy, currently a resident at the University of Tennessee, has been named a recipient of the 2023 Humanitarian Grant by the Urology Care Foundation. The Foundation acknowledged Dr. Roy's efforts at the Sadbhavna Trust Hospital in Kalsar, Bhavnagar, Gujarat, India, where he provides extensive training in routine and complex urologic surgery and post-operative care. He has been making a notable impact, particularly in underserved communities, under the mentorship of Dr. Amar Singh.

In a similar vein, **Dr. Rajiv K Singal**, a Surgeon-in-Chief at Michael Garron Hospital in Toronto and a fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of Canada, was also awarded the 2023 Humanitarian Grant. Dr. Singal's contribution includes his work at Zomba Central Hospital in Malawi, where he has collaborated with the Malawi Medical Council and the College of Surgeons of Eastern Central and Southern Africa (COSECSA). His efforts are geared towards creating a long-term sustainable solution to the challenges of urologic care in the region.

The Urology Care Foundation, through these grants, recognizes the exceptional efforts of urologists in providing critical patient care and education in areas where such medical services are desperately needed

His work spans over two decades, focusing on tuberculosis, nutrition, diabetes, and access to medicines. Dr. Atre, a Fulbright-Nehru Postdoc Fellow at Harvard Medical School, is also known for his contributions as a reviewer for The Lancet journals and an academic editor for PLOS Global Public Health. His work in the World Health Organization's Global TB Program and his significant number of publications and citations highlight his impact in the field.
