DR. SUNEEL KUMAR PARVATHAREDDY RECEIVES PHYSICIAN LEADERSHIP CERTIFICATION

Dr. Raju's dedication to eye care and his significant contributions to the community were recognized at this prestigious event, celebrating his lifelong commitment to improving eye health and his impactful service to society.

DR. GAGANDEEP KANG AWARDED PRESTIGIOUS JOHN DIRKS GAIRDNER GLOBAL HEALTH AWARD

Dr. Gagandeep Kang, an esteemed Indian researcher, has been honored with the 2024 John Dirks Canada Gairdner Global Health Award for her remarkable achievements in global health research.

Dr. Kang was awarded for her extensive cohort-based epidemiological, environmental, and clinical trial research on enteric diseases in children and their effects on life course. Her work has had a profound impact on vaccine development and health policy in India and internationally. Over the past 20 years, her research group has conducted significant community-based birth cohort studies, generating crucial data on childhood enteric infections, growth, and development. Notably, Dr. Kang led the largest single birth cohort study on rotaviral



infections globally, revealing that protection after natural infection is lower in India than in developed countries. This finding has significant implications for disease control through vaccination. Her efforts have been instrumental in developing and introducing two Indian rotavirus vaccines into the national immunization program, showcasing her enduring contributions to public health.

INDIAN-ORIGIN EXPERT ASHWINI JOINS BRITAIN'S RESEARCH TEAM ON DEMENTIA

Dr. Ashwini Keshavan, an Indian-origin neurologist, has been selected to join a prestigious research team in the UK focused on dementia. This world-class team is tasked with conducting groundbreaking research to detect dementia through blood tests and gathering more evidence to support this approach.

Dr. Keshavan is part of a team investigating p-tau217, a promising biomarker for Alzheimer's disease. Her research aims to evaluate this specific protein's potential as an indicator of Alzheimer's, one of the most common forms of dementia. Researchers from Oxford and Cambridge universities are also testing various proteins to detect other types of diseases that can cause dementia.



The research conducted by Dr. Keshavan's team aims to revolutionize dementia detection and treatment. The involvement of Indian-origin researchers like Dr. Ashwini Keshavan in international collaborations highlights India's growing expertise and contributions in healthcare and scientific research.

DR. CHANDRA KANNEGANTI APPOINTED CBE IN WINDSOR CASTLE CEREMONY


