DR. GEORGE MATTHEW HONORED WITH A STREET NAMED AFTER HIM IN ABU DHABI

Dr. George Matthew, an Indian-origin doctor, has been honored by the UAE with a street named after him in Abu Dhabi, recognizing his 57 years of dedicated service to the country's healthcare sector. Part of the "Honoring UAE's Visionaries: Commemorative Streets" project by the Department of Municipalities and Transport, George Matthew Street is located near Sheikh Shakbooth Medical City in Al Mafraq.

Arriving in the UAE in 1967, Dr. Matthew chose to stay after being captivated by Al Ain's beauty, becoming the region's first government doctor. He played a significant role in the development of modern healthcare in the UAE, holding key positions such as Medical Director of Al Ain Region and Health Authority Consultant.

His work included serving the royal family, for which he was granted UAE citizenship.

INDIAN-ORIGIN DOCTOR PERFORMS UAE'S FIRST PEDIATRIC LIVER TRANSPLANT

Dr. Rehan Saif, an Indian-origin surgeon, has made history by leading the UAE's first pediatric liver transplant at Burjeel Medical City (BMC). The groundbreaking surgery involved a fouryear-old girl, Razia Khan, who suffered from a rare genetic liver disorder called Progressive Familial Intrahepatic Cholestasis type 3 (PFIC). The transplant, a 10-hour procedure, was conducted with her father as the living donor, marking a significant achievement for the UAE's medical sector.


Razia's condition had severely affected her growth and quality of life, and her family had already lost their first daughter to the same disease. After careful evaluations, Dr. Saif, originally from Bangalore and now based in the UK, determined that a liver



transplant was the only curative option. The successful surgery has not only saved Razia's life but also set a new benchmark for medical advancements in the region.

DR. HEMANT KHEMANI AWARDED SHINING STAR AWARD 2024 AT NATIONAL INTERVENTIONAL COUNCIL

The NIC 2024 also featured significant discussions on the burden of heart diseases in India, the procedures and expenditures involved in treating heart ailments, and the launch of a dedicated hall for innovators in interventional cardiology.

INDIAN-AMERICAN SCIENTIST DR. SAMEER SHETH DISCOVERS NEW BIOMARKER FOR OCD

Indian-American scientist Dr. Sameer Sheth and his team of researchers have identified a groundbreaking neural activity pattern associated with obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD). This discovery could revolutionize how the condition is monitored and treated, particularly for patients who have undergone deep brain stimulation (DBS) therapy.

The research, conducted at Baylor College of Medicine and Texas Children's Hospital, focuses on the low-frequency brain oscillations in the theta to alpha range, crucial to cognitive processes. Using advanced DBS devices capable of both stimulating and recording brain activity, the team was able to observe changes in neural patterns in real-life situations, outside of the controlled lab environment.



Dr. Sheth highlighted that this newly identified neuro-psychological biomarker could serve as a more precise tool for assessing the effectiveness of OCD treatments and potentially be applied to other mental health conditions with similar neural characteristics.

INDIAN-AMERICAN MICROBIOLOGIST LALITA RAMAKRISHNAN AWARDED 2024 ROBERT KOCH PRIZE

Dr. Lalita Ramakrishnan, a renowned Indian-American microbiologist, has been awarded the prestigious 2024 Robert Koch Prize for her groundbreaking research on tuberculosis. Currently a professor of Immunology and Infectious Diseases at the University of Cambridge, Dr. Ramakrishnan has made significant contributions to understanding TB through her innovative use of a zebrafish model. Her work has led to new insights into the disease's mechanisms and the development of potential treatments. The Robert Koch Prize is one of Germany's most esteemed scientific awards, recognizing outstanding contributions to medical research. Dr. Ramakrishnan will receive the award at a ceremony in Berlin on November 8, 2024.
