Indian American Cardiologist Dr. Rajesh Mohan Wins Republican Primary in New Jersey's 3rd Congressional District

Indian American cardiologist Dr. Rajesh Mohan has secured the Republican primary in New Jersey's Third Congressional District, marking a significant step in his political journey. Dr. Mohan, a resident of Holmdel, garnered 12,677 votes, equivalent to 38% of the total, defeating immigration consultant Shirley Maia-Cusick and financial advisors Gregory Sobocinski and Michael Francis Faccone by a wide margin.

Expressing his gratitude after the win on June 4, Dr. Mohan stated that he is "honored and grateful for the support" from the residents of the district and emphasized his commitment to bringing "common-sense solutions" to issues that resonate across party lines. He contrasted his approach with that of his Democratic opponent, Socialist Democrat Assemblyman Herbert Conaway, Jr., highlighting his intention to reduce regulations, support businesses, and maintain jobs in the U.S.

Dr. Mohan's victory positions him to compete in the upcoming November election for the seat previously held by Rep. Andy Kim, who is running for the U.S. Senate. As a board-certified interventional cardiologist with an MBA, Dr. Mohan aims to bring his clinical problem-solving approach to government, focusing on issues such as border security, Medicare and Social Security preservation, domestic manufacturing, and healthcare reform.

Experts Highlight AI and Precision Medicine as Pivotal in Revolutionizing Indian Healthcare

At a national round table held at the Institute of Life Sciences (ILS) in Bhubaneswar, experts underscored the transformative potential of artificial intelligence (AI) and precision medicine in revolutionizing India's healthcare landscape. The event, organized in collaboration with the Technology Information, Forecasting, and Assessment Council (TIFAC), New Delhi, served as a precursor to the action plan for Viksit Bharat 2047.

Dr. Pradeep Srivastava, Executive Director of TIFAC, highlighted the urgent need for India to reclaim its position as a global leader in pharmaceuticals by becoming self-sufficient in producing active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) and key starting materials (KSMs). He emphasized that advancements in technology, particularly AI, could help overcome challenges posed by the shortage of doctors and diagnostics infrastructure. AI can facilitate preliminary screenings, while precision medicine, tailored to individual patients' genetic and environmental factors, promises better therapeutic outcomes.

The discussions also focused on addressing the spread of vector-borne diseases influenced by climate change and exploring the potential of health tourism to boost the economy. Dr. Debasis Dash, Director of ILS, stressed that precision medicine could significantly enhance treatment effectiveness, particularly in oncology, by considering patients' genetic makeup in therapy design.

This round table marks a crucial step towards integrating advanced technologies into India's healthcare strategy, ensuring that even the remotest regions have access to state-of-the-art medical care.

Significance of Imaging in Infertility Treatment Highlighted by Prof. Rajul Rastogi

In the latest GAPIO Radiology International Lecture Series, Prof. Rajul Rastogi, Senior Radiologist at Teerthanker Mahaveer Hospital and Research Centre, Muradabad, delivered an insightful online lecture on the critical role of imaging in diagnosing and treating female infertility. The session titled "Role of Imaging in Diagnosis and Treatment of Female Infertility" emphasized the centrality of various imaging techniques such as 2D and 3D ultrasound, SIS, sonohysterosalpingography, hysterosalpingography, and MRI in assessing and managing infertility.

Prof. Rastogi, who has over 23 years of experience in radiology, discussed how these imaging methods are pivotal in diagnosing uterine and ovarian abnormalities, which are often underlying causes of infertility. He highlighted ultrasound as the most effective tool for identifying these abnormalities, while other techniques provide additional, detailed information that aids in comprehensive treatment planning.

Prof. Rastogi's contributions to the field are well-recognized, with over 185 research papers presented at national and international conferences, and more than 195 publications. His work has been widely cited, and he has received numerous awards at both national and international levels.




Indian Medical Association Honors Dr. Shukla Raval for Community Service on National Doctors Day




GAPIO 8.0 Session on Stroke Rehabilitation: A Comprehensive Update

- Dr. Richa Mittal from India, who served as the chairperson, contributed to the session's success by guiding the conversation and providing valuable insights into the topics discussed.



- **Encourage Persistence**: Remind patients that making lasting changes takes time and effort. Success often requires trial and error, but with persistence, meaningful improvements in health and well-being are attainable.

By incorporating these strategies into daily practice, healthcare professionals can help themselves and their patients make sustainable lifestyle changes that lead to a healthier, longer life.
