
IAP-GAPIO International Lecture Series: Paediatric Gastroenterology


This session offered valuable insights into surgical innovations, equipping healthcare professionals with the knowledge to enhance patient outcomes through advanced robotic procedures.

By promoting comprehensive sexual and reproductive health services, we can work towards reducing unintended pregnancies, preventing sexually transmitted infections, and advancing gender equality.




World Marrow Donor Day 2024: GAPIO Celebrates the Life-Saving Gift of Blood Stem Cell Donation








National Nutrition Week 2024: GAPIO Celebrated Nutritious Diets for a Healthier Tomorrow
