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GAPIO Member Dr. Rajul Rastogi Delivers Expert Lecture on Elastography in Liver Cancer at International Conference

Dr. Rajul Rastogi, GAPIO Member and a Senior Radiologist in the Department of Radiodiagnosis at Teerthanker Mahaveer Hospital & Research Center, delivered a distinguished lecture at the "International Conference on Ultrasound Imaging – DopplerCon 2024". The conference was hosted by the prestigious Teerthanker Mahaveer University (TMU) and focused on cutting-edge advancements in ultrasound imaging. Dr. Rastogi's lecture, titled "Role of Elastography and Fat Quantification in Hepatic Imaging," shed light on the critical application of elastography in liver cancer diagnosis and management. He emphasized the growing significance of advanced imaging techniques in accurately diagnosing hepatic conditions, staging liver diseases, and monitoring treatment efficacy.

During his presentation, Dr. Rastogi elaborated on:

- The potential of elastography in differentiating between benign and malignant liver lesions.
- Its role in assessing liver stiffness for early detection of fibrosis and cirrhosis.
- How fat quantification methods are transforming the understanding and management of hepatic steatosis.

The event also featured consultations on adopting healthier lifestyles, with a focus on dietary habits and physical activity to prevent and manage diabetes.









GAPIO Delegation under the leadership of Dr Sanku Rao, Past President of GAPIO, visits Zanzibar and Engages with the President and Health Minister

In October 2024, a delegation of 24 physicians from the USA visited Tanzania and Zanzibar under the Global Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (GAPIO). While the primary purpose of the trip was the Serengeti Safari, the delegation also had the honor of meeting Hon. Dr. Hussein Ali Mwinyi, President of Zanzibar, and Hon. Nassor Ahmed Mazrui, Health Minister. The meeting, arranged by Dr. Nazir Arab, GAPIO member and Presidential Council member residing in Tanzania, also included discussions with Dr. Salim Slim, Secretary of Health.

The meeting, held under the banner of GAPIO, provided an opportunity to introduce the organization and its mission to improve healthcare globally. Dr. Sanku Rao, representing GAPIO, appraised the President of GAPIO's vision and the willingness of its members—comprising experts across various medical fields—to collaborate and contribute toward advancing healthcare in Zanzibar.

During the meeting, Dr. Rao highlighted critical areas for collaboration, emphasizing the need to identify skill gaps, deficiencies in infrastructure, and both short- and long-term healthcare goals. A specific example was presented around reducing Zanzibar's Infant Mortality Rate (IMR) and Maternal Mortality Rate (MMR). Zanzibar's IMR stands at 42 per 1,000 live births, compared to the USA's 5.3 per 1,000, while MMR in Zanzibar is 145 per 100,000 live births, against the USA's 22.3 per 100,000.

The President acknowledged these challenges and shared the need to first focus on improving infrastructure in District Hospitals before moving forward with collaborative initiatives. The delegation expressed readiness to support Zanzibar in achieving sustainable improvements in healthcare through knowledge sharing and capacity building. This meeting symbolized GAPIO's commitment to fostering global partnerships and leveraging its expertise to address critical healthcare challenges worldwide. It marked a significant step toward strengthening the healthcare landscape in Zanzibar through meaningful collaboration.

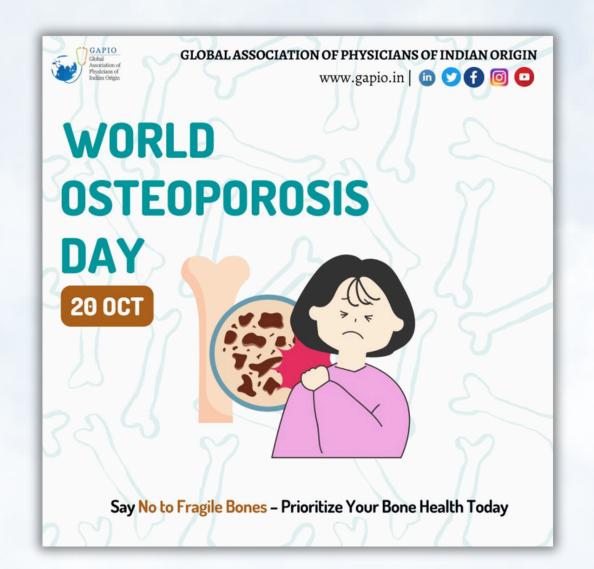
World Osteoporosis Day: Say No to Fragile Bones

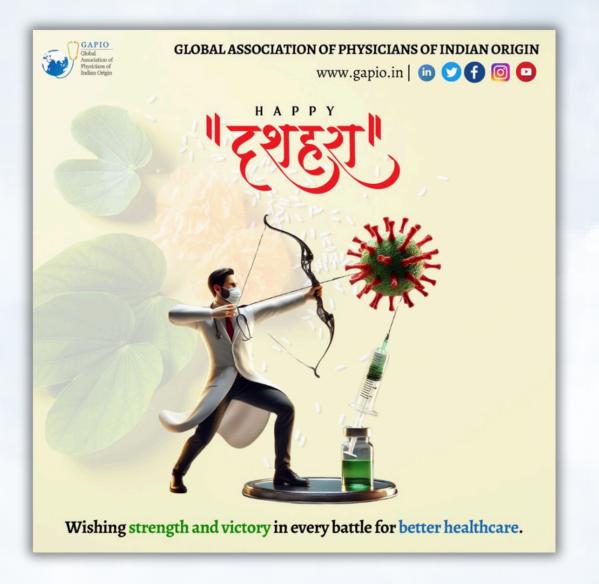
Dusshera: Strength and Victory for Better Healthcare

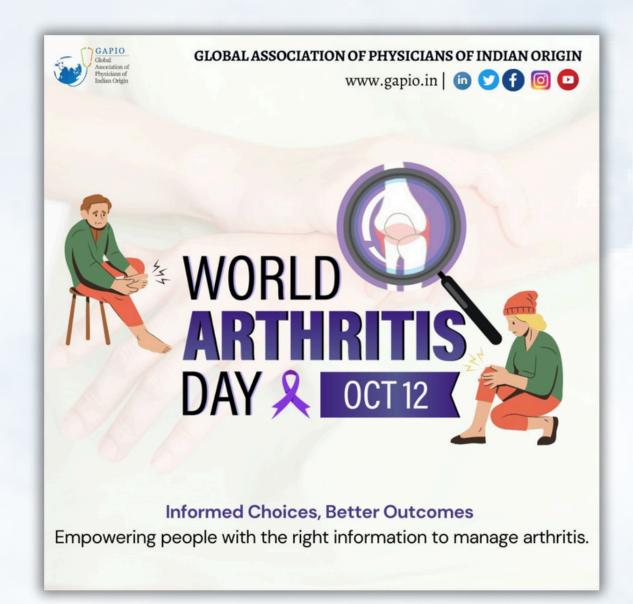


World Arthritis Day: Promoting Informed Choices for Better Outcomes

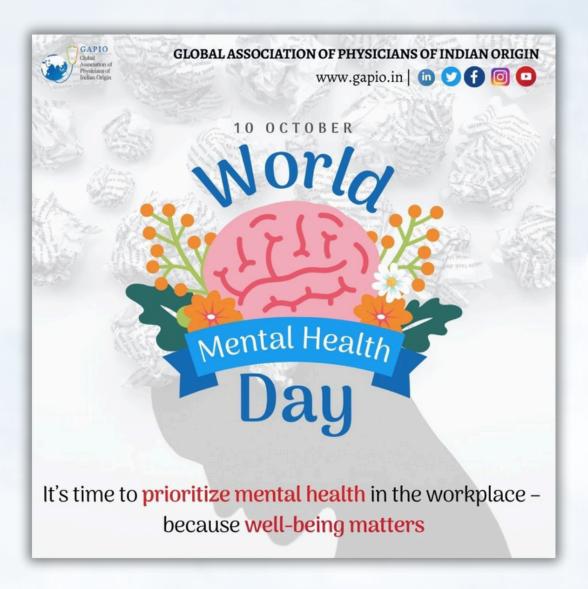


World Mental Health Day: Prioritizing Well-Being in the Workplace

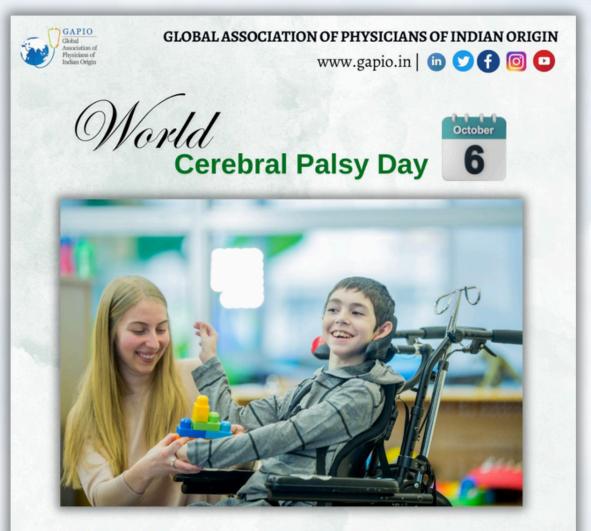


World Cerebral Palsy Day: Celebrating Uniqueness and Advocating Inclusion

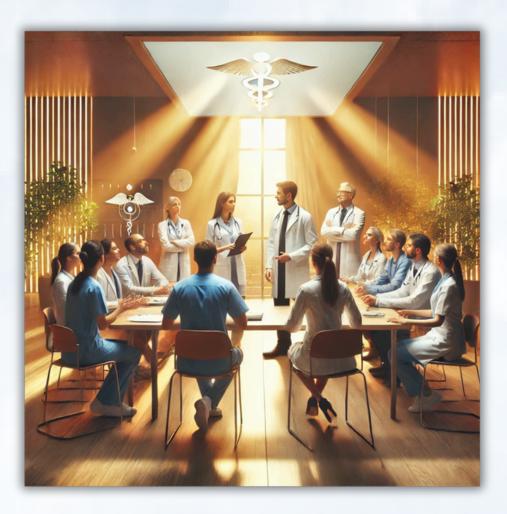
