#### SURGEON VICE ADMIRAL ARTI SARIN BECOMES FIRST WOMAN DG OF ARMED FORCES MEDICAL SERVICES

Surgeon Vice Admiral Arti Sarin has become the first woman to take charge as Director General, Armed Forces Medical Services (DGAFMS) on October 01, 2024. With a career spanning 38 years, she has held numerous prestigious positions, including DG Medical Services (Navy), DG Medical Services (Air), and Director & Commandant of AFMC Pune.

An alumna of AFMC Pune, Dr. Sarin is an MD in Radiodiagnosis and has undergone advanced training in Gamma Knife Surgery at the University of Pittsburgh. Her exceptional service across all three branches of the Indian Armed Forces has earned her the Ati Vishisht Seva Medal (2024) and Vishisht Seva Medal (2021), among other honors.

She continues to inspire young women in the Armed Forces and is an advocate of the Nari Shakti initiative.


