DR. PRABIR ROY-CHAUDHURY APPOINTED AS NEXT PRESIDENT OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF NEPHROLOGY

Dr. Prabir Roy-Chaudhury, MD, PhD, FASN, has been named the next President of the American Society of Nephrology (ASN), succeeding Dr. Deidra C. Crews, whose term concludes on January 1, 2025. Currently serving as the Drs. Ronald and Katherine Falk Eminent Professor and Co-Director of the University of North Carolina Kidney Center, Dr. Roy-Chaudhury also practices as a nephrologist at the WG

(Bill) Hefner VA Medical Center in Salisbury, North Carolina.

Contributions to Kidney Care and Research:

- Research Focus: Uremic vascular biology, particularly addressing dialysis vascular access dysfunction and cardiovascular complications in kidney disease.
- Leads a multidisciplinary translational research program funded by the NIH, Veterans Administration, and industry grants.

Leadership and Public Policy:

- Dr. Roy-Chaudhury has held leadership roles across key organizations, including:
 - American Society of Diagnostic and Interventional Nephrology
 - Vascular Access Society of the Americas
 - Kidney Health Initiative (ASN co-chair)
- He also served as Past President of the American Nephrologists of Indian Origin and is a member of the Kidney X Innovation Accelerator Steering Committee.

Recognitions:

- Author of over 250 publications and book chapters.
- Recipient of numerous awards, including the Gerald Beathard Award (American Society of Diagnostic and Interventional Nephrology) and the KS Chugh Oration (Indian Society of Nephrology).

The four esteemed individuals who have brought laurels to India are:

Dr. Arvind Chopra

A distinguished figure in the field, Dr. Chopra, Director & Chief Rheumatologist at the Center for Rheumatic Diseases Pune, is globally recognized for his pioneering work in population-based rheumatic disease studies, particularly through the WHO ILAR COPCORD program. His research has significantly contributed to the understanding and management of rheumatic diseases in India.

Prof. Durga Prasanna Misra

Prof. Misra, an Associate Professor at the Department of Clinical Immunology and Rheumatology at Sanjay Gandhi Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, is a leading expert in vasculitis, endothelial biology, and the epidemiology of rheumatic diseases. His research has been instrumental in advancing the field of rheumatology in India and globally.

Dr. Amita Aggarwal

Dr. Aggarwal, Professor and Head of Clinical Immunology and Rheumatology at Sanjay Gandhi Postgraduate Institute, Lucknow, is a renowned clinician-scientist with a focus on juvenile arthritis and systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE). Her contributions to the field, including the establishment of a multi-institutional lupus network, have significantly impacted patient care and research.

Dr. Aman Sharma

Dr. Digambar Behera, Professor Emeritus at the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh, and a Padma Shri awardee, has been appointed as the President of the National Academy of Medical Sciences (NAMS). He succeeds Dr. S.K. Sarin, the outgoing President, during a convocation function held at AIIMS Jodhpur, where the Vice President of India graced the occasion as the Chief Guest.

Dr. Behera, a former Dean at PGIMER and currently Director of Pulmonary Medicine and Critical Care Medicine, will serve as President of NAMS for a three-year term. He joins an illustrious list of PGIMER stalwarts, including Dr. P.N. Chutani, Dr. B.K. Sharma, Dr. N.K. Ganguly, and Dr. K.K. Talwar, who have previously led NAMS.

DR. SHYAM SUNDAR NANDI HONORED FOR DEVELOPING RAPID MPOX DIAGNOSIS TEST AND ADVANCING POLIO SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Dr. Shyam Sundar Nandi, a scientist at the National Institute of Virology (NIV), has been awarded by India's top medical research body, the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), for his groundbreaking work in developing a rapid molecular test capable of diagnosing mpox in just one hour. This innovation significantly improves upon conventional PCR tests, which can take up to a full day, and surpasses rapid antigen tests that are often prone to inaccuracies.



Dr. Nandi was felicitated during the annual Health Research Excellence Summit hosted by ICMR in New Delhi. His pioneering contributions also include the innovative use of gene-editing technology (CRISPR) to enhance polio safety protocols in research labs nationwide.

Highlights of Dr. Nandi's Achievements:

- Rapid Mpox Testing Kit
 - Utilizes LAMP technology for quick and visual virus detection through a color change, eliminating the need for advanced lab equipment.
 - Plans are underway for global distribution in public and private healthcare settings.
- Addressing Mpox
 - Over 24,000 cases reported globally this year; India saw two cases in 2024.
 - Mpox spreads through close contact, causing painful rashes, blisters, and fever.
- Polio Safety with CRISPR
 - CRISPR technology prevents polio virus growth in labs by creating non-permissive cells, ensuring safety for researchers and reinforcing India's polio-free status.

Dr. Jay Bhattacharya, MD, PhD, Professor of Health Policy at Stanford University, has been nominated to serve as the Director of the National Institutes of Health (NIH). Announced by President Donald J. Trump on November 26, 2024, Dr. Bhattacharya will work alongside Robert F. Kennedy Jr. to lead the nation's medical research efforts, with a focus on addressing chronic illness and improving public health outcomes.

Dr. Bhattacharya, an expert in health economics and biomedical innovation, is well-recognized for his research on the health and well-being of vulnerable populations. He is also a co-author of the Great Barrington Declaration, which proposed alternatives to lockdowns during the COVID-19 pandemic. As a medical doctor and public health researcher, Dr. Bhattacharya has dedicated his



career to addressing major health challenges, particularly in chronic diseases, aging, and innovative biomedical solutions. He directs Stanford's Center for Demography and Economics of Health and Aging, contributing extensively to healthcare advancements for vulnerable populations.
