Prof. (Dr.) Rajul Rastogi, GAPIO Member, Delivers Key Lectures at AOCR 2025, Chennai

On the occasion of Indian Republic Day, Prof. (Dr.) Rajul Rastogi, a distinguished radiologist and member of the Global Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (GAPIO), took center stage at the Asian-Oceanian Congress of Radiology (AOCR) 2025. The international conference, hosted in Chennai under the aegis of the Indian Radiological & Imaging Association (IRIA), brought together global experts to discuss groundbreaking advancements in radiology.

Dr. Rastogi delivered two impactful lectures and presented five pioneering research studies at the prestigious gathering. Among his key contributions was his research on "Prognosticating Epilepsy by Artificial Intelligence-Based Brain Volumetric Analysis", which explores the role of AI in neurological imaging.

In addition to his presentations, Dr. Rastogi was honored with a Faculty Recognition Award, reinforcing his role as a leading educator and researcher in the radiology community.

Speaking about his experience, Dr. Rastogi expressed his gratitude for the opportunity to share his insights on an international platform. GAPIO Partners with GHE to Conduct Free Health Screening Camps in Rajasthan

Global Health and Education, Inc. (GHE), in collaboration with the Global Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (GAPIO), successfully conducted five Free and Charitable Health Screening Camps in the Sawai Madhopur/Ranthambore region of Rajasthan from 24th to 28th January 2025. These camps aimed to screen, diagnose, and manage Hypertension (HTN) and Diabetes, two of the most prevalent and growing health concerns in rural Rajasthan. A total of 387 patients were screened, revealing that 49.7% had elevated blood pressure or hypertension, while 38.2% showed hyperglycemia or diabetes indicators based on random blood glucose levels. Urgent cases, including one patient in hypertensive crisis, were referred for immediate medical attention, while others received free antihypertensive and antidiabetic medications along with counseling on follow-up care.

The initiative extended beyond HTN and diabetes, addressing respiratory ailments, arthritis, and other chronic conditions, and providing economically disadvantaged patients with medications from the Prime Minister's Jan Aushadhi Kendra. Given the challenges rural patients face in accessing continuous care, GHE and GAPIO recommend implementing a community-based follow-up system, leveraging Anganwadi health workers for home visits to monitor blood pressure, glucose levels, and medication adherence. The camps not only reinforced the importance of early detection and preventive healthcare but also underscored the need for sustainable, long-term interventions to improve rural health outcomes in India.

Bengaluru Doctors Develop AI-Powered Device for Rapid Cancer Diagnosis

Bengaluru-based doctors Dr. Narayana Subramaniam and Dr. Hardik Pandya have pioneered an AI-driven cancer screening device capable of diagnosing cancer in less than two minutes. Designed for affordability and portability, this digital pathology platform aims to make early cancer detection accessible, particularly in rural and underserved areas.

The innovation, which recently secured a \$2.4 million grant from the National Institutes of Health (NIH), USA, uses AI-powered slide scanning to analyze samples and detect abnormal cells instantly. Unlike traditional biopsy methods that require lab processing and days of waiting, this device provides real-time results, making it a game-changer in mass cancer screening.

The team is in discussions with government and private entities to integrate this cost-effective technology into healthcare systems. With trials underway, the device is expected to achieve over 90% accuracy and be market-ready within five years, bringing faster, affordable cancer diagnostics to those who need it most.
