Dr. Kulkarni also serves as Director of the RWJBarnabas Women's Heart Center and President of Medicor Cardiology. Beyond medicine, she is Vice Chair of Akshaya Patra USA, working to combat child hunger through mid-day meal programs across India.

Dr. Pankaj Dangle and **Dr. Harshit Garg**, both of Indian origin, have been named recipients of the 2025 Urology Care Foundation Humanitarian Grant, an initiative of the American Urological Association supporting global efforts to improve urologic care in underserved regions.

Dr. Dangle, a pediatric urologist at Riley Hospital for Children and associate professor at Indiana University Health, completed his medical training at the University of Mumbai before advancing his expertise in the United States. His pediatric fellowship was undertaken at the University of Pittsburgh's Children's Hospital.

Dr. Harshit Garg, recognized for his work in India, joins Dr. Dangle as part of a global cohort of awardees from countries including Kenya and Trinidad. The announcement was made by the Foundation on July 9, 2025.

This recognition highlights the critical work being done by Indian-origin doctors to expand access to urologic care and improve outcomes in low-resource communities.

DR. LOKESWARA RAO SAJJA INDUCTED INTO SIGMA XI SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH HONOR SOCIETY

Dr. Lokeswara Rao Sajja, Senior Consultant Cardiothoracic Surgeon at STAR Hospitals and Chairman of the Sajja Heart Foundation, has been inducted as an Associate Member of Sigma Xi, The Scientific Research Honor Society—one of the world's most prestigious scientific organizations.


Founded in 1886 at Cornell University, Sigma Xi honors individuals with outstanding contributions to scientific research. Dr. Sajja was recognized for his pioneering work in cardiovascular surgery, including leading India's first multi-centre randomized cardiac surgery trial (PROMOTE Patency Trial) and developing a mechanical heart valve that eliminates the need for long-term anticoagulation—an innovation holding both Indian and U.S. patents.

Membership in Sigma Xi is by invitation only and is extended to scientists who exemplify excellence in research and innovation. Dr. Sajja joins the ranks of renowned members like Albert Einstein, Richard Feynman, and Jennifer Doudna.

Expressing gratitude, Dr. Sajja remarked that this recognition strengthens his resolve to promote collaborative, patient-centric cardiovascular research from India on a global stage. His induction is expected to inspire young Indian researchers to pursue evidence-based science aligned with global standards.


