DR. SOUMYA SWAMINATHAN AWARDED HONORARY DOCTOR OF LAWS BY THE UNIVERSITY OF GUELPH

Dr. Soumya Swaminathan, former Chief Scientist at the World Health Organization (WHO) and Chairperson of the M S Swaminathan Foundation, has been conferred with an Honorary Doctor of Laws (LL.D.) by the University of Guelph, Canada.

The honour recognizes Dr. Swaminathan's outstanding global contributions to medicine, healthcare, public policy, and social welfare. Her pioneering work has advanced the One Health approach, integrating human, animal, and environmental health in addressing some of the world's most pressing challenges, including antimicrobial resistance and equitable access to care.

INDIAN DOCTOR COUPLE'S LANDMARK RESEARCH INFLUENCES MAJOR WHO POLICY ON TUBERCULOSIS CARE

A groundbreaking study led by **Dr. Anurag Bhargava and Dr. Madhavi Bhargava**, physician-researchers from Mangaluru, has directly shaped the World Health Organization's revised global guidelines on tuberculosis (TB) and undernutrition—marking one of the most significant contributions by Indian clinicians to global TB policy in recent years.

Their multicentre field study, the RATIONS trial (Reducing Activation of Tuberculosis by Improvement of Nutritional Status), published in The Lancet, provided compelling evidence that nutritional support to household contacts of TB patients can drastically reduce the risk of TB activation. The study demonstrated a 48% reduction in new pulmonary TB cases among household contacts who received nutritional supplementation.

Findings from the trial also showed that among TB patients, better nutritional status was closely linked to improved treatment outcomes and survival, reinforcing the importance of integrating nutrition into TB care. Recognizing the strength and real-world relevance of this evidence, WHO has now, for the first time, recommended food assistance for household contacts of TB patients in food-insecure settings—a major shift from earlier guidelines that focused solely on patient nutrition. The policy change reflects acknowledgement of the Bhargava team's work and represents a paradigm shift toward addressing social determinants in TB management.

This achievement highlights the profound global impact of high-quality research led by Indian clinicians. Dr. Anurag Bhargava and Dr. Madhavi Bhargava's contribution stands as a milestone in shaping equitable, community-centred TB care worldwide, reinforcing the role of Indian medical research in informing global health policy.

PADMA SHRI DR. B. K. S. SANJAY CONFERRED WITH THE WELLNESS EXCELLENCE AWARD 2025

Padma Shri Dr. Bhupendra Kumar Singh Sanjay, renowned orthopaedic surgeon and distinguished medical leader, has been honoured with the Wellness Excellence Award 2025 at the 2nd International Conference on Wellness (Wellness Con 2025) held in Lucknow. The award recognises his exceptional contributions to promoting public awareness on preventive healthcare, wellness, and healthy living.

At the conference, organised by PRAYATNA in association with the Hind Institute of Medical Sciences, Dr. Sanjay delivered a keynote address emphasising that "Health is not only an asset, but a national resource which must be nurtured." He highlighted the importance of the Health, Education and Nutrition (HEN) model as the foundation of national progress, and presented his practical wellness framework DEWS — Diet, Exercise, Work and Sleep, describing it as a cost-effective model to improve population health.

Dr. Sanjay urged regular medical check-ups, early diagnosis, and basic home health monitoring tools such as weighing scale, thermometer, blood pressure monitor, glucometer, and pulse oximeter for every household. He also called for a nationwide Health Screening Awareness Campaign, reiterating that "prevention is better than cure" and linking preventive health with nation-building and India's vision of Viksit Bharat.

A pioneering orthopaedic surgeon, Dr. Sanjay has been recognized globally for his remarkable surgical feats, including setting a world record in 2005 for successfully removing the largest tumour of bone recorded worldwide. His contributions are documented in the Limca Book of Records, the Guinness World Records, and the India Book of Records.


