



FIRST INDIAN SURGEON DR RAGHU RAM ELECTED TO 425-YEAR-OLD RCPSG GOVERNING COUNCIL

Dr P. Raghu Ram, Founder Director of KIMS-USHALAKSHMI Centre for Breast Diseases, Hyderabad, has become the first surgeon from India to be elected to the Governing Council of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow (RCPSG), a 425-year-old institution and one of the world's oldest medical colleges.

RCPSG is the only multidisciplinary Royal College in the UK and Ireland, representing medical professionals across 97 countries. The results were announced during the College's Annual General Body Meeting held in Glasgow on December 5, 2025.

This year's election was historic as only one Governing Council seat is reserved for a surgeon practising outside the UK, with 26 global candidates contesting for it. Dr Raghu Ram's victory marks a rare milestone in the combined history of UK Royal Colleges.

He will serve on the Governing Council for the 2025-2028 term, representing RCPSG members across countries outside the UK. Since 2000, Dr Raghu Ram has played a key role in strengthening the College's academic presence in India through FRCS and MRCS preparatory programmes, training over 2,000 surgeons across South Asia.

An OBE recipient, Padma Shri awardee and Dr B C Roy National Award winner, Dr Raghu Ram was also recently conferred the Honorary FRCS (Glasgow), the highest honour of the College.

DR. ANEES MOHAMED HONOURED BY UZBEKISTAN AFTER SAVING WOMAN DURING MID-FLIGHT MEDICAL EMERGENCY

Dr. Anees Mohamed, a Malayali medical intern currently training at Tashkent State Medical University, has been conferred Uzbekistan's rare and prestigious "Hero of the Country" honour after saving the life of a woman who collapsed during a mid-air medical emergency.

The incident occurred on July 28, 2025, aboard a flight travelling from Tashkent to Delhi, when a 48-year-old woman suddenly collapsed mid-air. Responding to an urgent call for medical assistance, Dr. Anees—then just 24 years old—stepped forward as the only medical professional on board.

With no medical equipment and thousands of feet above the ground, Dr. Anees assessed the passenger and identified a case of tachycardia, marked by a dangerously elevated heart rate. He immediately performed a carotid sinus massage, stabilising the patient within seconds. The woman was closely monitored until landing and subsequently handed over to doctors in Delhi for further care.

For his presence of mind and decisive intervention, Dr. Anees was officially honoured at a ceremony in Uzbekistan on December 4, 2025, becoming the first Indian and the first foreign national to receive the country's "Hero of the Country" award.

Accepting the honour, Dr. Anees credited his family, mentors, and university for guiding him, stating that the recognition belonged to everyone who supported his journey. Though raised and schooled in Dubai, Dr. Anees hails from Tirur in Malappuram district, Kerala, and frequently returns to India during academic breaks to work in hospitals across the state.

Aspiring to specialise in trauma surgery, Dr. Anees has already assisted in major surgical procedures in India and maintains a detailed surgical logbook despite being an intern. Outside medicine, he is also a trained MMA and kickboxing coach, mentoring young athletes at competitive levels.

In an official statement, Tashkent State Medical University said it was proud that its students were providing life-saving medical assistance globally, reflecting the quality of training imparted at the institution.

Dr. Anees Mohamed's recognition highlights the growing global impact of young Indian medical professionals and stands as a testament to the role of medical training, courage, and compassion in saving lives beyond borders.

DR J. NARESH BABU WINS TOP HONOURS AT INDIAN ORTHOPAEDIC ASSOCIATION MEET

Dr J. Naresh Babu, Chief of Spine Services at Mallika Spine Centre, Guntur, has brought national recognition to Andhra Pradesh after winning three prestigious national awards at the 70th Annual Conference of the Indian Orthopaedic Association (IOA), held in Guwahati.

Dr Naresh Babu was conferred the HKT Raza Gold Medal 2024 for Best Spine Research for his pioneering work on identifying ideal candidates for Endoscopic Spine Surgery, a minimally invasive technique that is redefining modern spine care.

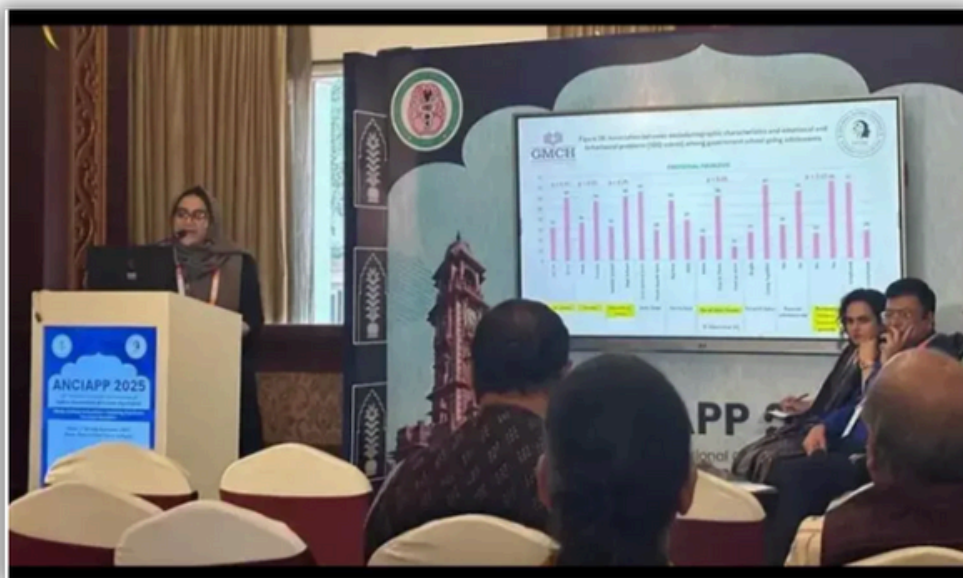

INDIAN ROBOTIC SURGERY PIONEERS DR SUDHIR SRIVASTAVA AND DR SUDHIR RAWAL RECEIVE GOLDEN ROBOT SURGICAL AWARD 2025 IN NEW YORK

US HEALTH SCIENCES UNIVERSITY RENAMED AFTER INDIAN-AMERICAN PHYSICIAN PHILANTHROPISTS DRS KIRAN AND PALLAVI PATEL

*Orlando Health Sciences University in the United States has officially been renamed Drs. Kiran and Pallavi Patel Global University (KPGU), honouring the extraordinary philanthropic contributions of Indian-American physicians **Dr Kiran C. Patel and Dr Pallavi Patel**. With this landmark decision, the couple has become the first individuals of Indian origin to have a US university named in their honour.*

Dr Kiran Patel, a renowned cardiologist, healthcare entrepreneur and philanthropist, began his medical journey in Gujarat before moving to the US in 1976. His wife, Dr Pallavi Patel, is a paediatrician widely respected for her commitment to child healthcare and community service. The couple is especially recognised for their transformative support of osteopathic medical education.

Their philanthropy includes a \$200 million donation to Nova Southeastern University in 2017, one of the largest higher-education gifts in Florida's history. They have also committed \$20 million towards free education through a charter school in Florida and invested \$60 million in clinical testing of next-generation cardiovascular devices in the US.

In India, the Patels have launched a \$200 million initiative to improve healthcare access in rural regions and have established medical institutions, including a university in Gujarat bearing the same Patel Global University name—strengthening academic ties between India and the United States.

Dr Kiran Patel's global impact has been recognised with the Pravasi Bharatiya Samman by the Government of India in 2019 and the Outstanding American by Choice Award in 2017. Over the past two decades, the couple's combined philanthropic commitments are estimated to exceed \$1 billion, marking a lasting legacy in global healthcare and education.

INDIAN OPHTHALMOLOGIST DR CYRES K. MEHTA BECOMES FIRST INDIAN TO WIN ITALY'S TOP OPHTHALMOLOGY HONOUR

Renowned Indian ophthalmologist Dr Cyres K. Mehta, Director of Dr Cyres K. Mehta's International Eye Centre, has made history by becoming the first Indian eye doctor to receive the prestigious Benedetto Strampelli Medal Lecture, the highest honour in Italian ophthalmology, conferred by the 150-year-old Società Oftalmologica Italiana (SOI).
